

Chief of Police-Town of Triana

The Town of Triana, Alabama, is actively seeking qualified candidates for the Chief of Police. Candidates must possess a thorough knowledge of the principles and practices of police administration, demonstrate excellent communication and interpersonal skills.

The Police Chief is appointed by and works under the direction of Mayor.

The Department is budgeted for four full time Patrol Officers and the Chief of Police, serving approximately 5,500 residents.

The Chief of Police is responsible for maintaining and improving the efficiency and effectiveness of all areas under their direction for protecting and serving the community. The Police Chief will also be responsible for directing the internal and external activities of the Police Department in the enforcement of the laws, regulations and town ordinances.

RECOMMENDED QUALIFICATIONS

- Applicants must satisfy all requirements set forth by the Alabama Peace Officer Standards and Training Commission (APOSTC) for certification as a Police Officer in the state of Alabama.
- Education: Bachelor's Degree in Law Enforcement, Criminal Justice or related field. Master's Degree preferred but not required. Familiarity with the state of Alabama Police Accreditation process; familiarity and experience with community-oriented policing process; or an equivalent combination of education and experience.
- Experience: A minimum of ten (10) years' experience in law enforcement, with at least two (2) years in a significant command or supervisory capacity.
- Possession of or ability to obtain a valid Alabama driver's license.
