Mayor Caudle's Report: Interviewed for new officer, Chief Powell did a recommendation for hire. Waiting on him to get back to us on a start date. Applicant's name is Tavaris Hines, he will be full-time and hopefully start in two weeks.

REPORTS OF STANDING COMMITTEES:

Fire & Police: Chairperson Ragland reported Police Dept. traveled 2504, made 20 traffic stops, 16 warning citations, 6 citations, 51 calls for service, 0 arrests and 7 reports.

Fire Dept. made 18 emergency calls and 1 accident.

Mr. Ragland stated we need two police cars because one car has over 100,00 the other has over 120,000. Mayor Caudle stated we added one car to the budget to start with.

Finance: No Report

Utility: Chairperson Whitman reported work is ongoing on the pump stations.

Park & Recreation: Chairperson Ayers reported the Christmas camp is going well. We had 15 to 25 students on last week. They will be going from the 27th thru 30th.

Streets & Cemetery: No Report

Mayor Caudle stated Mr. Ragland had brought up about Ms. Toney on Landess Cir., the County is scheduled to come out and fix that.

Resolutions, Ordinances, Orders and Other Business:

Mr. Whitman, Planning and Zoning reported the developers for the Apartments have given an updated layout of what they would like to see and do. They wanted to run it past council before they start doing their engineer drawings and layout. The layout has changed slightly since last presented. They plan to build no more than 50 units. Mr. Whitman pointed out changed on the map. Mayor Caudle stated it's been well over a year and they just want to make sure Council is still good with what was approved. Council in agreement.

Councilmember Garstka asked if there were any updates on take home vehicle for the police. Mayor Caudle stated it will be over a year before we do any take home cars. Councilmember Ragland just

mentioned about the high mileage on the patrol cars. We will have to get some new cars before we can consider that.

Public Comments:

Patsy Parvin reported a street light out at 798 Wall Triana Hwy before the Landess Cir turn. Ms. Parvin stated she attended the Toy Drive that was held at the Fire Dept. She stated she was very impressed, very successful. She personally thanked the Mayor and Mr. Ragland for showing up like they always do to support the kids in the town. They were the only two City Officials she saw there. She stated she would like to invite everybody else to show up when it's something like that especially for the kids. Good to see city officials there.

George Malone thanked Sharron for working with him with getting his turned water on.

Roy Seay piggybacking off of what Ms. Parvin has said, he thinks it was good also but that it can be even better next year. He was told Parks & Rec had something going on. If they would like to getting together and he's sure they could make it bigger and better
