

**Town of Triana  
Regular Council Meeting  
Tuesday, May 26, 2020  
6:30p.m.**

The mayor called the meeting to order, the clerk was asked to call the roll, Council Members Casey Whitman, Levoneia Ayers, George Ragland, Zach Atchley, Marvelene Freeman and Mayor Mary Caudle. Members present constituted a quorum.

Legal counsel Caleb Ballew and the clerk Sharron Humphrey were also present.

**Mayor Caudle's Report:** Been looking and pricing tractors for the maintenance department. We need to look at purchasing a finishing mower the one we have is old and needs to be replaced.

Council member Freeman asked the Mayor to have employees to cut the dead dogwood trees on 6<sup>th</sup> Street.

Mayor stated she would speak with the employees.

**REPORTS OF STANDING COMMITTEES:**

**Fire & Police:** Chairperson Atchley reported the Police Dept., 1863 miles, made 55 Traffic Stops, 54 Warning Citations, and 11 Citations, 37 Call for Service, 1 Arrest and 6 Reports.

**Utility:** Chairperson Ragland reported Madison Utilities damaged a customer's fence on Foster Dr., while repairing a service line leak.

Mayor asked the clerk to contact Madison Utilities regarding the matter.

Councilman Ragland stated customers living on Oregon Dr., have been complaining about their water pressure.

Councilman Ragland we have several water customer's on cutoff.

Mayor stated we will hold off on the disconnections because a lot of people have just gone back to work, she stated we will work with them.

**Park & Recreation:** Mayor Caudle reported the work in gym is coming along good, they have put up the double doors outside and the bathrooms are looking pretty good.

**Streets & Cemetery:** Chairperson Whitman reported most of the streets have been sprayed for mosquitos, got rained out this last time also tuned up the machine.

Bridge mill and Savannah Subdivisions have street signs missing or need to be replaced.

Discussion about cemetery requirement: Question about balloons and stuff being placed on graves.

Mayor stated the plants and stuff around the old graves were grandfathered in. The clerk was asked to give out copies of the cemetery ordinance when a grave is purchased so they will know the requirement.

Council member Ayers asked how the town will enforce the three month rule on headstones. Councilman Ragland stated we will send them a letter. Mr. Ragland stated town needs a Bush hog not a finishing mower.

**Resolutions, Ordinances, Orders and Other Business:**

Burn Ordinance presented brief discussion, Attorney Ballew was asked to have final draft ready for council to vote on at next meeting. Mayor stated too much burning is going on in the town.

Councilman Whitman presented the Rezoning Ordinance. He stated this will rezone Brookfield Manor Subdivision on Zierdt Road for the purpose of building 103 Townhomes on about 12 acres.

Councilman Ragland asked about the impact this will have on Foster Dr. Lift Station, who will repair it if there's a problem.

Councilman Whitman stated the town would repair it like we do the others.

Councilwoman Freeman stated she has fire and police issues, she asked are we prepared to protect the people moving in and we're going to have to provide thorough fire protection.

Councilman Whitman stated the planning and zoning board operates off of the guidance of the Zoning and Subdivision Ordinance. They need a comprehensive plan growth policy to help guide them.

Councilwoman Freeman stated she is not ready to consider the Ordinance.

Work session and joint meeting scheduled with Planning and Zoning Board for Monday, June 1<sup>st</sup> at 5:30 to hear and discuss the rezoning plans and issues.

Mayor Caudle reported some of the electrical work being done in some of the homes does not meet building code; she is concerned that we are not catching this.

**Public Comments:**

Dan Bualock, a resident of Bride mill Subdivision reported he has issues with the electrical work that was done in his house; he has had to correct some electrical problems himself.

Mayor stated she has been trying to set up a meeting with the builder and developer regarding issues the residents is having in Bridge mill.
